## **PROJECT UPDATES**

#### **RESEARCH**

- Collecting and structuring data for the development of the Urban Vulnerability and Transformability Index (IVTU).
- Designing a multi-dimensional survey to assess urban vulnerability, opportunity, and transformability across different Romanian cities.
- Developing the structure for the CityFocus dashboard, which will visualise key indicators and insights in an accessible and interactive format.
- Living Lab activities in Iaşi, including the development of a citizen-centered governance framework and building strong connections with local stakeholders.
- Collaborating on grant proposals to further support applied urban research and experimentation.

Methodological seminar *Artificial Intelligence in Research - Expanding the Frontiers of Knowledge and New Risks*

- Refinement of the urban vulnerability and resilience model, including scenarios, good practice examples, and policy recommendations.
- Development of the digital warehouse and a gamified citizen engagement platform (GCEP) to encourage participatory urban governance.
- CityFocus Living Lab workshop to share findings and co-design local solutions with stakeholders.
