

About CITY-FOCUS

The City-Focus Project is designed to enhance the understanding of EU cities' resilience and develop a theoretical framework for assessing urban vulnerabilities and transformation capacity.

The project also seeks to provide an evidence-based urban governance model using intelligent technologies and smart city solutions to achieve sustainable urban quality.

The project will be implemented by an interdisciplinary team, coordinated by an internationally renowned researcher (Karima KOURTIT), who will make a significant contribution to the development of knowledge and practice in the field of European studies and regional and urban development.

KEY OBJECTIVES:

- Develop an innovative theoretical model for assessing urban vulnerabilities and transformation capacity
- Evaluate resilience performance in Romanian cities
- Create a shared knowledge base using urban development indicators
- Generate a replicable citizen-based framework and smart solutions for responsive city organization
- Enhance research and management skills among academics, support early-stage researchers, and promote an integrative, interdisciplinary approach to urban studies
